PUBLIC FORUM

- Mr. Kevin Johnson, private citizen, addressed the board with concerns about parent involvement on school committees i.e., Parent Advisory Group and School improvement Advisory Committee. He asked for an explanation of the process of how a person becomes involved with the committees, as he does not have children attending Clover Schools. CSD received the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) and the Certificate of Excellence in Financial Reporting from the Association of School Business Officials International (ASBO) for financial reporting for fiscal year 2021.
